GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS

- 1. Abstracts should preferably contain previously unpublished results.
- 2. Materials should be submitted in Ukrainian (for citizens of Ukraine); English, Polish or Russian for foreign participants.
- Materials should be ready for printing MS Word for Windows format (.doc). Paper size: A4. Font: Times New Roman, font size 11 pt, 1.1 spacing. Margins: top 20 mm, bottom 27 mm, left 18 mm, right 25 mm.
- 4. Abstracts: 1 or 2 full pages including figures and tables. Number of authors not more than three.
- 5. Structure of abstract:
- 1 line initials and surname of the author and co-authors (2 coauthors font halfbold,11, right);
- next line affiliations (font 11, right);
- 1 interval title of abstract, capital letters (font halfbold, 14, center);
- 1 interval mark ©, initials and surname, year (italic, 11, left);
- 1 interval main text.
- 6. The use of illustrations here should be minimal. All figures are to be grouped as a single object. Bibliography sources should be numbered in the text order. Attributions and pages served in brackets. References given at the end of the abstract according to stated requirements.

GUIDELINES FOR ARTICLES

In the Visnyk (Official Gazette) of Lviv Polytechnic National University "Management and Entrepreneurship in Ukraine: Stages of Formation and Development Problems"

The bulletin consists of five sections: "Management", "Entrepreneurship", "Investment and Innovations", "Management of National Economy" and "Economics and Management of Scientific and Educational Activities"

Article language: Ukrainian, Russian, English.

11, space 1,1, font Times New Roman Cyr.

Paper format A4 (210 x 297 mm). Indenting: left - 1.8 cm, right - 2.5 cm, from the top - 2 cm, bottom - 2.7 cm. Fields mirrored. Headers - 1.25 cm, footers - 1.6 cm. Page numbers are not tabulated.

The first line on the right indicates the UDC (bold). Each following line:

- initials and surname of the author(s) (bold, in the right);
- the name of organization, where the author(s) work (in the right);
- article title in capital letters (font = 14, bold, centered);
- surnames and initials of the author(s) (italics, left from the sign ©) and the year of writing;
- abstract in Ukrainian (Russian) (additional retreat 1cm, bold.

An abstract in Ukrainian or Russian is given in the 6-7 lines (600-700 symbols without spaces. An abstract in English – the whole page (2700-3000 symbols without spaces). It should display a summary of article and include its aim, objectives, results of research findings, conclusions;

- key words (not more than 8 words, bold, left indent – 1sm).

In a line the author's surname, the name of organization, title, abstract and key words are given in English at the same order, than in Ukrainian (Russian). In one line – the main text of the article.

The titles of the tables placed in the center (font size 11 bold), and the numbers to the right of the table in italics. Font size for typing in table 10.

Formulas are performed in the format of Equation 3-5, aligned to the centre and numbered to the right in parentheses. Font definition for MS Word: normal - 11pt, large index - 9pt, small index - 7 pt, big symbol - 18pt, small symbol - 11pt.

Drawings should be made with Microsoft Office or inserted in a publication in raster formats *tif, *psd, *jpg with a resolution of 300 dpi. Inscriptions under the drawings should be performed with the typefaces Times New Roman Cyr font size 10. Drawings made in MS Word should be grouped and be available for correction.

The References (should be obligate) are given at the end of publication in italics (the word "References" should not be written). The references should be issued under

the form 23 of Bulletin of VAK of Ukraine, № 5, 2009). Number of references at least 8 titles on which in the text of the article should be at least one link.

The length of publication - 6-10 pages.

The authors submit the articles only during the conference with the package of documents:

1. The disk with the article file or it can be sent by e-mail.

2.Two paper copies of article (contrast print). On the first page of the article there should be the signs of the author(s) and the scientific advisor or the head of the department where the author(s) work.

3.Two reviews – internal and external (both with the certified signs). The reviews Дві рецензії - внутрішню і зовнішню (обидві з завіреними підписами). The reviews should cover: a description of the research object, the relevance of the work, scientific novelty, the value of the results of research, flaws in the work, recommendations and proposal for publication in the Visnyk. The volume of review - at least one full page.

4. Extract from the minutes of the meeting of structural unit about the consideration of publication and its recommendation of printing.

5. A request letter from the management of the organization where the author works or studies, on the name of Vice Rector for Scientific Research of Lviv Polytechnic National University N.I.Chukhray requesting publication of the article.

6.Information of the author(s).

The article submission to the expert bulletin is possible only during the conference and is free of charge. Oher options are not considered!

The printed version of the Visnyk will be sent to the authors. The authors will receive an electronic version of the bulletin by e-mail, specified in the Information of the author(s). The printed version will be sent to libraries in Ukraine with the relevant speciality.
